Meet our Rwandan friend Pastor Mulindahabi Ildephonse. He is a man with a great heart who loves coffee, does everything he can to create community within his district, and yearns for justice for his people.



We first met Mulindahabi Ildephonse a year ago as Land of a Thousand Hills Coffee™ began to invest specifically in the district of Bukonya in Northern Rwanda. We built a coffee washing station and helped form a coffee cooperative so the area growers could come together to produce better coffee and earn a fair and Living Wage. Ildephonse is one of these coffee farmers, but much like our own founder, he has more than one type of work. He is also the district's pastor who works alongside the growers to help bring healing to his people, cares for the orphans of his village, and strives to redeem a once war-torn nation. An anchor for the people and a foothold of good in this land, Pastor Ildephonse is a quiet leader who tends his coffee trees and his community. He brings people together despite ethnic differences and demonstrates the redemption that only Christ can bring. Ildephonse teaches the coffee growers how to heal, work together, and forgive each other.

He and Jonathan are the only "Coffee Pastors" we know and they quickly became friends over Jonathan's gift of a harmonica during a coffee celebration in Rwanda. When asked what more could Land of a Thousand Hills Coffee™ do to help, Ildephonse replied, "Build homes for our orphans." There are more than 100 child led homes in Bukonya. This inspired our next vision of *Doing Good: Building Bukonya*. We plan to build homes and provide shoes and education for Bukonya's orphans.
